3 Steps for Toy Safety

Malcolm Harbour, West Midlands Conservative MEP, is backing the European Toy Safety Campaign during the run up to Christmas.

Mr Harbour said: "This is the time of year when many toys are bought for our children and grandchildren and it is important those toys are safe.

"Imported toys must now meet the stringent EU safety standards that we have come to expect from our own manufacturers.

"Just three steps will help ensure only safe toys are bought. Firstly, never buy toys that do not have the CE Mark. Secondly, do read all warnings and instructions and thirdly, always buy toys from trustworthy shops and online outlets."
