MEP in high-profile visit to Shropshire home of Lord Robin Hodgson

Local MEP Philip Bradbourn attended a high-profile event at the Ludlow home of Lord Robin Hodgson on Friday and spoke about the positive changes that are taking place in the European Parliament and the exciting position the Conservative MEP delegation have within their new political grouping.

Speaking from Shropshire on Friday, Mr Bradbourn, who is also a leading member of the Transport committee in the European Parliament, said:
