Local Euro MP visits proposed site of rail re-opening

Local Conservative MEP Philip Bradbourn visited the site of the proposed re-opening of the Avon Rail Link today. The proposal to reinstate an eight mile rail link between Stratford on Avon to Honeybourne is a move thought to offer benefits to the area, including enhancing tourism, and improving transport links for local residents.

Mr. Bradbourn, a senior member of the European Parliament's Transport Committee said:

“After visiting the site in Long Marston, this is a project of interest and potential importance to Stratford on Avon. I will be watching closely at developments in the proposal to re-open this stretch of the rail link south of Stratford on Avon, and will continue to assess the potential benefits to tourism.”
