## **Euro MP warns Councillors of continued problems with regional tier government**

Local MEP Philip Bradbourn spoke to members of the Conservative Group on Worcestershire County Council on Friday morning, warning local councillors about the continuing problems of local quango Advantage West Midlands and the negative impact that European interference in local transport policy is having in Worcestershire.

**Speaking from Worcester on Friday, Mr Bradbourn, who also sits on the Transport Committee in the European Parliament said:**

**“We must also continue to oppose renegade regional tier quangos who offer poor value for money and inconsistency. I do not see why we should be constrained by somebody’s artificial designation as to what a region is. I believe in addressing the values of constituents at the most local level possible, and that is what I will continue to do.”**
